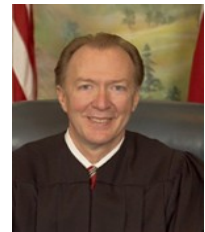
Although this is an "off year" we need to stay focused on the job ahead, Election 2012.
