In the last two weeks the committee assignments were published for the 86th Session of the Texas Legislature.

Senator Bob Hall from Senate District 2, which includes Rockwall County, was appointed Chairman of the Senate Agriculture Committee. In addition, he was appointed Vice-chairman of the Veteran Affairs & Border Security, State Affairs, Education, and Nominations.

Representative Holland from House District 33, which includes Rockwall County, was appointed to the State Affairs and to the Committee on Culture, Recreation and Tourism.

Rockwall County will be represented in both chambers with members on the influential State Affairs committee which deals with, among other things, utilities, communications and social concerns. Hall's chairmanship on the Agriculture committee gives him an important leadership responsibility in the Senate. In addition to State Affairs, Holland's appointment to the Culture, Recreation and Tourism committee affords him exceptional opportunities to influence the sporting and tourism industries important to Rockwall County.

In this session, Rockwall County is well-represented in the leadership of the State legislature.

The filing deadline for local elections is February 15, 2019. Additional information will be provided once received from each City. Here is what we know as of today as officially reported by each City Secretary:

Heath- All the incumbents that are running are unopposed except for Rich Krauss, whose opponent is Johnny Meyers.

Royse City – All the incumbents that are running are currently running unopposed.

McClendon-Chisholm – Will not release any official information until after the deadline.

Rockwall – Candidate for Mayor is Jim Pruitt, City Council Place 1 is Bennie Daniels, City Council Place 3 is Kevin Fowler, City Council Place 5 is Dana Macalik.

Fate – Candidate for Mayor is Lorne Megyesi and candidate for City Council Place 6 is John P. Brandt.






